How many people go to KYCK?

We are hoping to take between 10 and 20 youth to KYCK in 2022. Our group will be joined by approximately 1000-2000 other youth (depending on COVID restrictions) to hear great Bible talks, sing and play games.

Where will we be staying?

We stay up in the blue mountains at two houses owned by church members. Once registrations are finalised and we allocate accommodation. We will let you know the address of the house your teen will be housed in. We usually do girls in one house and boys in the other. The rooms are a mix of single beds and bunk beds.

What is the program?

How many Leaders will there be?

We are working with a ratio of 1 leader for every 5-7 youth. We will also have house parents who are members of the church who will be cooking our meals for us. All leaders on KYCK will have a Work with Children Check and complete safe ministry training (the Anglican diocese child protection course).

What food will my child be eating?

KYCK provides morning tea it includes a drink, a snack, and a piece of fruit. Morning tea is eaten at the KCC site. Our house parents will be cooking all our other meals, which will be eaten where we are staying unless otherwise noted. Any allergies or dietary requirements will be catered for if you let us know on the form!
