- C. How many times did Abraham question God?
- D. How does God respond each time?
- E. On what basis will God relent in his judgment?

2. God eventually does judge Sodom for their sin but he saves Lot and his family despite their reluctance. How is God's response in this chapter and chapter 19 different to what we might assume?

3. God is not threatened by our questions. Why do we question God and what is our aim?

4. How are we challenged to respond to God after considering his character?

5. Consider the life and ministry of Jesus. How is God's character reflected in Gen 18 seen more clearly in Jesus's life?

6. How can you bring your questions before God in a manner that reflects his character?

Heavenly Father, there is much we do not understand in life. Thank you that you are both just and merciful. Help us to bring our questions to you and leave with confidence in your character and plans. Amen

i. How have you experienced the care of others at St Stephen's?


ii. How can your GaP Group express care for each other that is shaped by the Gospel story and promises?

Friday Kids

Friday Kids is an after school kids programs for those in Kindy to year 4. We started Friday Kids at the beginning of the year in order to help reach the hundreds of non Christian families in our area. At the moment we have about 8-10 kids coming every week. Together we learn about Jesus, play games, eat food and have fun.
